THE BANANA AND PINEAPPLE GARDEN OF BENGUET

Sablan produces the juiciest Hawaiian pineapple and the most delicious bananas this side of Benguet. A large part of Sablan's fertile 8,640 hectares are planted with these revenue earning products. The remainder of the land is planted to rice, coffee and other fruit trees. Tiger grass grow abundantly along the hillsides making broom-making a lucrative home industry. Some natives of Ifugao engage in wood carving. These products earn for Sablan an average annual income of Php 13,506.18 making her a 7th class municipality.

Despite the absence of revenue-boosting industry in the municipality, Sablan's energetic mayor Mike Angel is exerting every effort to complete infrastructure projects such as gravity irrigations and feeder roads to remote sitios of the municipality.
