**A. Proposed Appropriation Language:**

For aid, relief and rehabilitation services to communities/areas affected by man-made and natural calamities, repair and reconstruction of permanent structures, including other capital expenditures for disaster prevention and operation, and rehabilitation activities, as indicated hereunder .....P **41,153,223.55**

**B. Special Provision on the use of fund:**

1. The thirty percent (30%) lump-sum for Quick Response Fund (QRF) shall be released or utilized when supported by a resolution of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan declaring that the Province is under the state of calamity; and
2. The seventy percent (70%) of the PDRRF is intended for disaster prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, rehabilitation and recovery to include procurement of early warning systems, preparedness equipment and other equipage for floods, earthquake, landslide and other natural and man-made calamities.
